## December 7, 2020 Erie County, Ohio Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) update

If your site is providing COVID-19 testing, and an individual tests positive, please ensure you are notifying the health department in a <u>timely</u> manner. We recognize that it may take 5-7 days for test results to come back, however, in order to effectively limit the spread of the virus, we must be notified as soon as possible and have access to the necessary information to contact the individual.
