*School district data is in a transitional period. Ohio Department of Education will be changing the way data is reported for the 2023 school year.

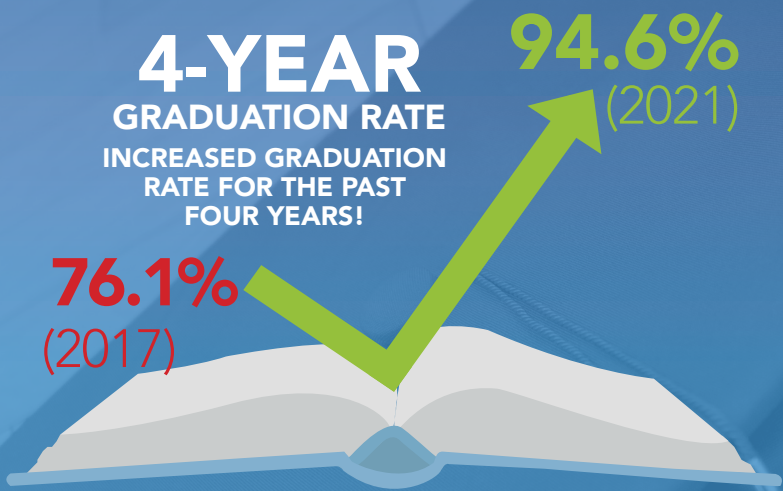
OPPORTUNITIES FOR GROWTH
